CLARIFICATION ABOUT THE LICENSE TO WORK IN TIMOR-LESTE AS A MEDICAL PRACTITIONER

The Ministry of Health would like to clarify that both Timorese and foreign students who have been conferred the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) degree from a college/university offering a faculty of medicine program recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education Science and Culture are allowed to practice as a medical practitioner, after acquiring the registration and license in Timor-Leste.

Furthermore, any foreigner having a valid medical degree from a recognized medical college/university is allowed to practice in Timor-Leste as a licensed medical practitioner or pursue higher medical education. The practice of medical acts in Timor-Leste is subject to compliance with current legislation on the registration of health professionals.
